- 2) What is the context in which Jesus makes His exclusive claim to be the only way?
- 3) How might we apply John 14:1: "You believe in God; believe also in me"?
- 4) How does Ecclesiastes 3:11 relate to our text?

Going Deeper

- 5) Apart from Jesus, what do all the other proclaimed 'ways' to eternal life have in common?
- 6) John Calvin comments that when Jesus says He is the way, the truth, and the life, it is like He is saying He is the beginning, the middle, and the end. What do you think of this?
