Going Deeper

- 6) Discuss this quote from Dietrich Bonhoeffer: "In the same way that the word of a person who is dear to me follows me throughout the day, so the Word of Scripture should resonate and work within me ceaselessly. Just as you would not dissect and analyze the word spoken by someone dear to you, but would accept it just as it was said, so you should accept the Word of Scripture and ponder it in your heart as Mary did."
- 7) What does it mean for us to 'watch and pray' as Jesus has commanded us in Matthew 26:40-41?
