Key Texts: Judges 4:1-24, Joshua 5:13-15, Hebrews 11, John 5:19

The Essentials

- 1) Read Joshua 5:13-15. How does this relate to our text?
- 2) Why might Barak hesitate in verse 9?
- 3) What are some other examples of Biblical characters doubting or hesitating when God tells them something?
- 4) What can we say about Deborah as a judge?
- 5) Think about any battles that you are currently going through. Ask yourself these two questions:
 - I. Have I surrendered and given this battle to God?
 - II. Do I *want* Him to get the victory and glory?

Going Deeper

- 6) How do we see that Deborah's faith fuels her courage?
- 7) A good rule of Biblical interpretation is that we don't make *prescriptions* from *descriptions*. Consider why this is so important.
