- 2) What does it mean to 'forget' God?
- 3) How might this 'forgetting' take place?
- 4) What do we know about Caleb, Othniel's uncle?
- 5) Why did the Holy Spirit come upon Othniel?

Going Deeper

- 6) What is the difference between the work of the Holy Spirit in the Old Testament and today?
- 7) Discuss this quote from Charles Spurgeon: "The love of God has been so overpoweringly experienced by us on some occasions, that we have almost had to ask for a stay of the delight because we could not endure any more. If the glory had not been veiled a little, we should have died of excess of rapture, or happiness."
