- 3) What might singles be concerned about that they hope getting married will solve?
- 4) Where does the text tell us our concerns should primarily be?
- 5) Would you agree that we often see singleness as a distraction rather than opportunity?

Going Deeper

- 6) What do you know about the life of David Brainerd?
- 7) Discuss this sentence and its implications: “Undivided devotion comes from an undivided heart”.
