The Essentials

- 1) Read Matthew 6: 9-13.
- 2) Reflect on the implications of embracing God as our Father in prayer.
- 3) Why do you think Jesus used the plural form (“our Father,” “give us,” “forgive us”) in this passage, even though He was teaching about personal prayer?

Going deeper

- 4) Describe the nature and significance of each of the six key elements (or requests) in Jesus’ model prayer (vs 9–13), and reflect on how each should be present in your own prayer life:
 - a) Worship and thanksgiving. Matt. 6:9b; Psalm 100
 - b) Intercession. Matt. 6:10a
 - c) Consecration. Matt. 6:10b; Luke 22:42
 - d) Petition. Matt. 6:11, John 3:27
 - e) Confession & repentance. Matt. 6:12 &14; 1 John 1:8-9
 - f) Preservation & protection. Matt. 6:13; 2 Thess 3:2-3
